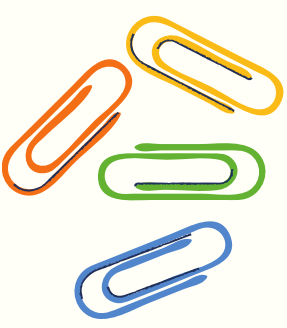
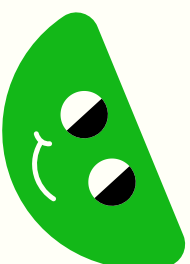
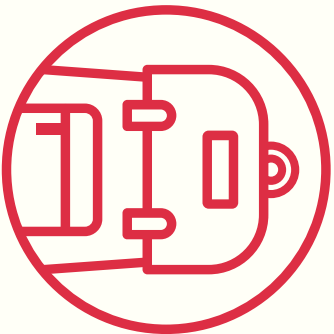




# RETURNING TO CAMPUS

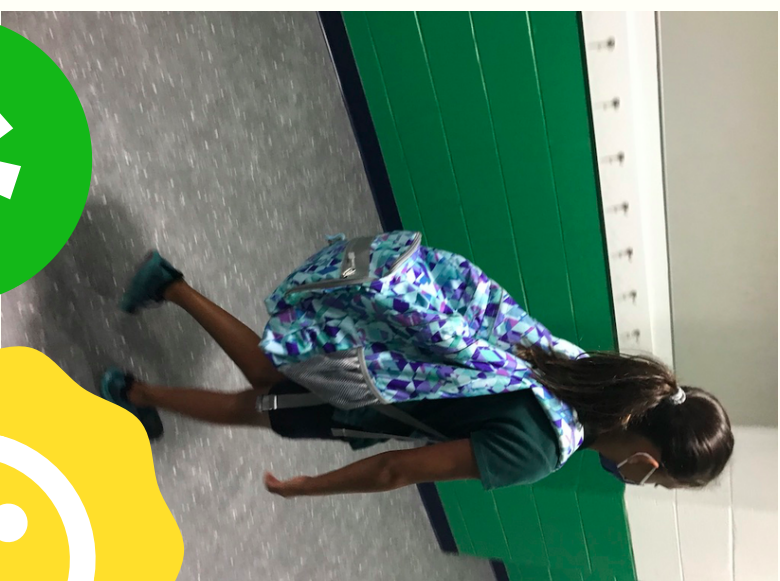

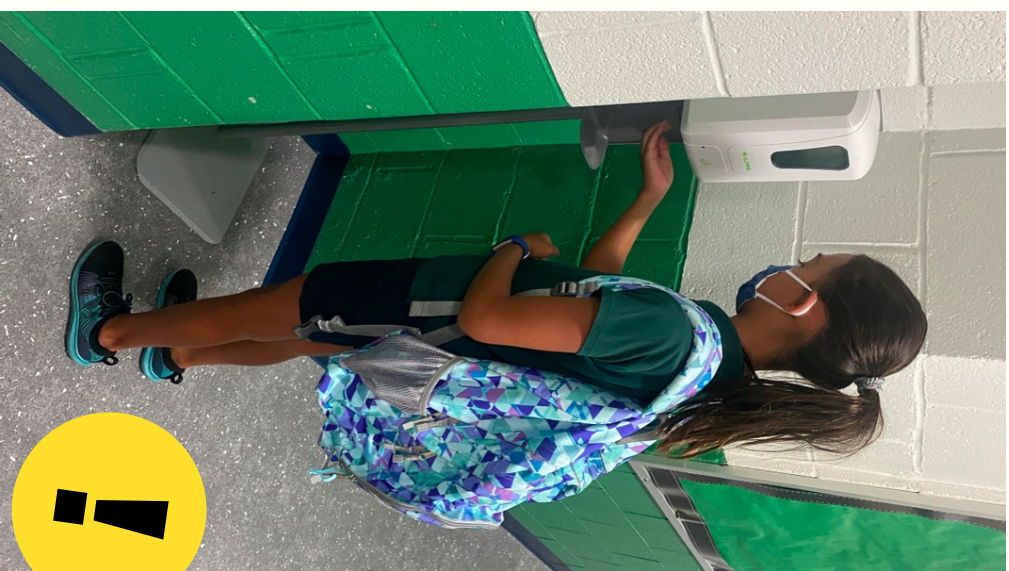

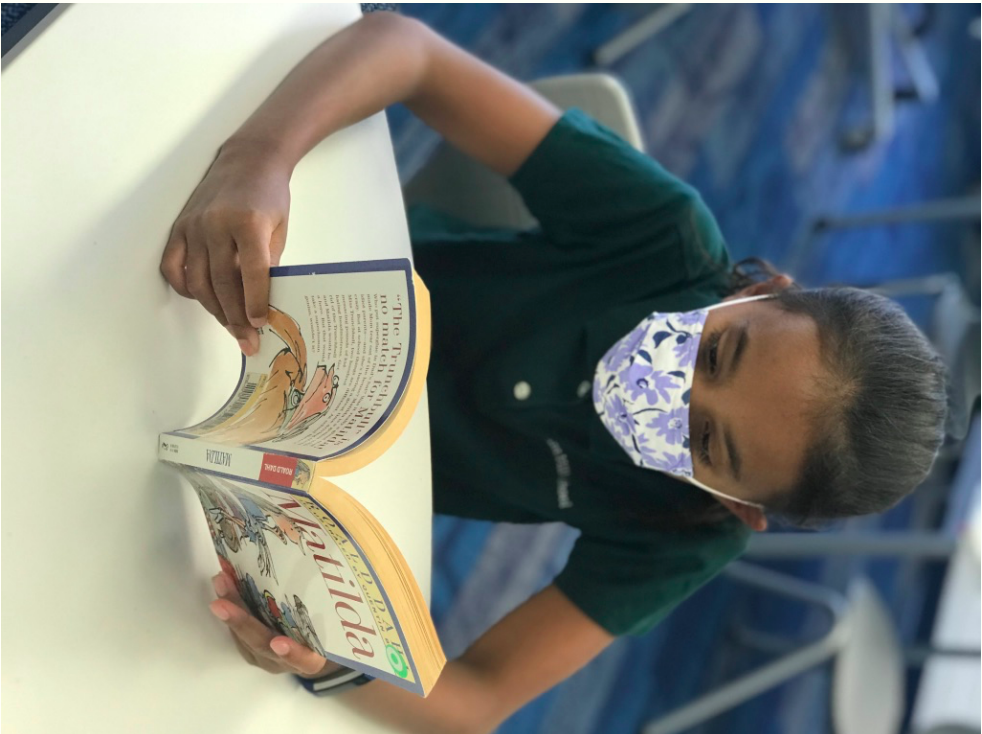


**I'm not able to stop by and

throughout the day.**

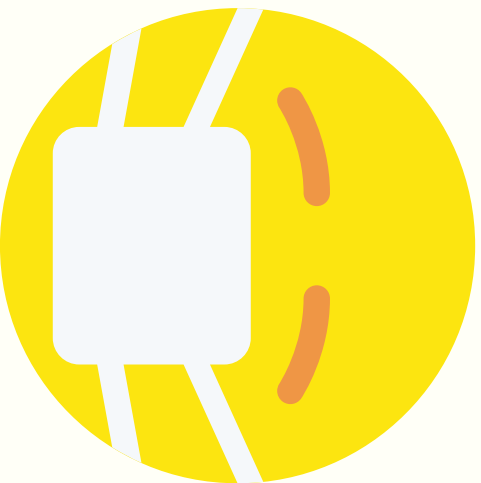




**After I wash/sanitize my hands, I will follow the teacher's directions to get my day started. My teachers will wear masks and will keep distance from students.**

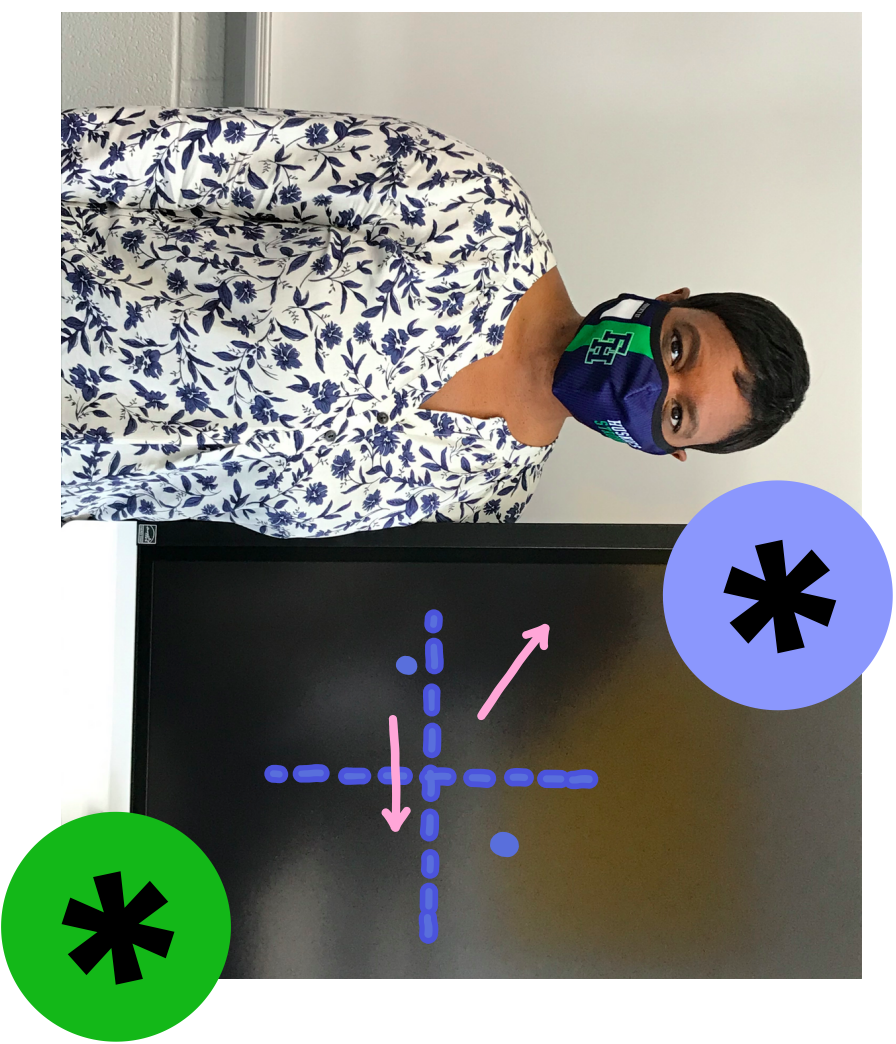


**My teachers will wear masks. The masks cover their mouths and noses, but we can still see their eyes!**



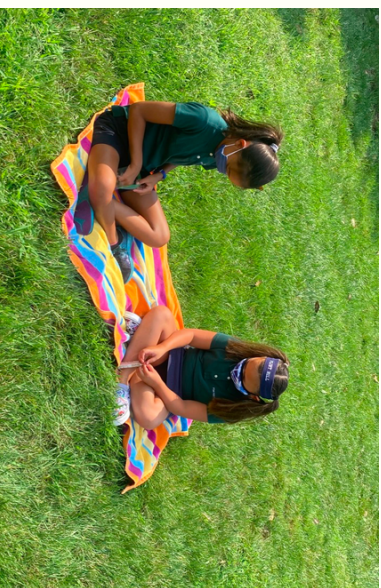
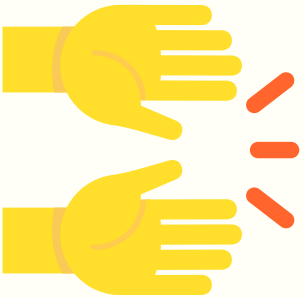
**All students, including me, will be wearing masks to keep everyone at school healthy and safe.**

subjects.**



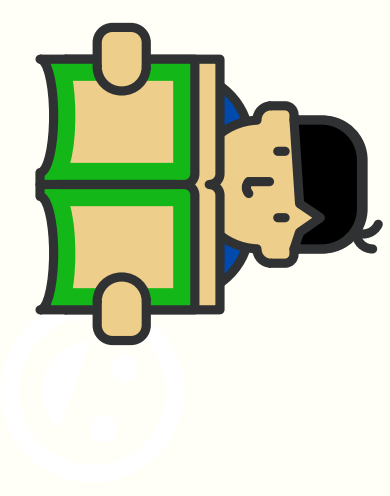
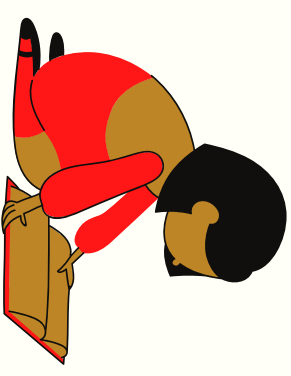


**We will get to spend time outside for break and for recess. Sometimes we might even get to eat lunch outside! We will still get to visit the playgrounds.**

**We will stay in our cohorts (COHORT is the word we use to describe the people in our class) all day.**



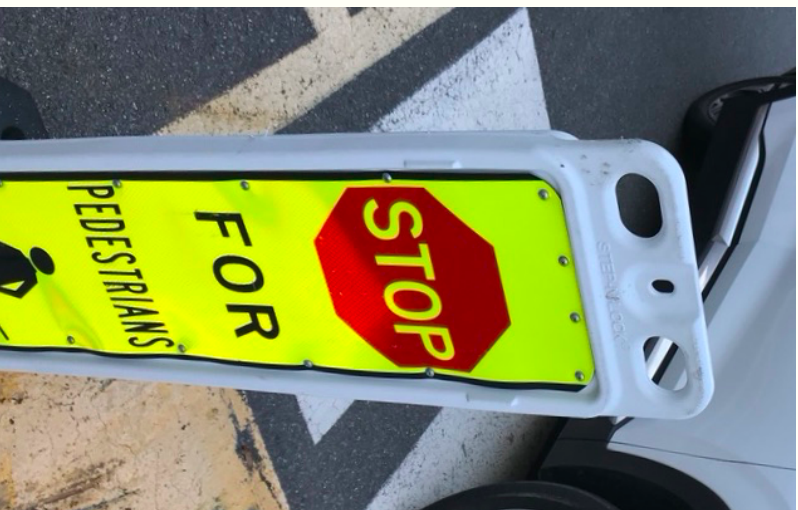

friends on campus.**

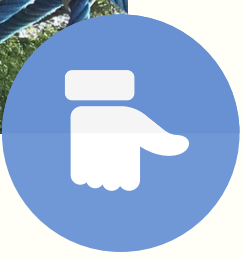
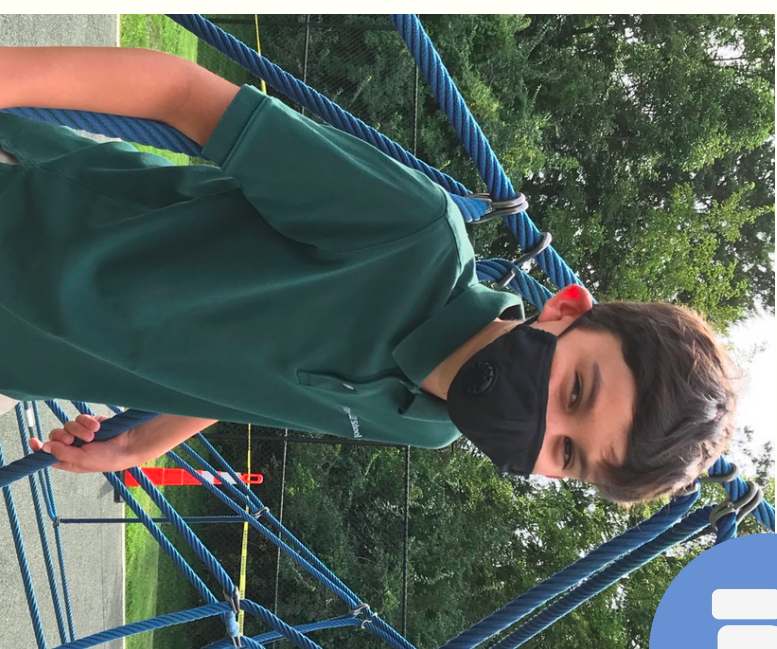
