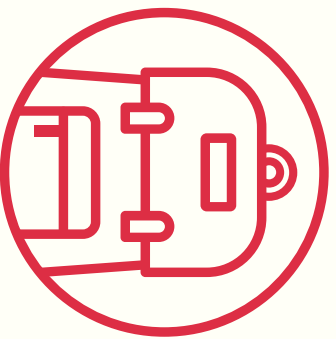
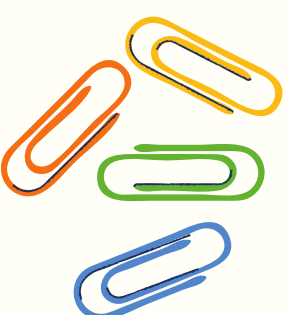
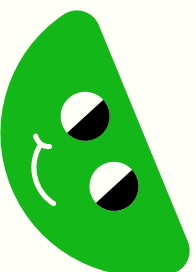




RETURNING TO CAMPUS

myself if I'm old enough.**

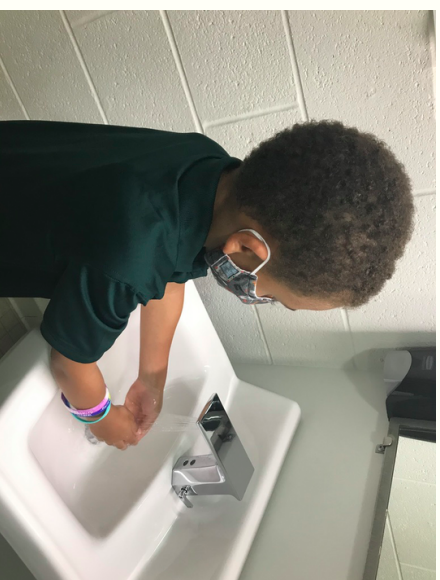


**Once I get to my

After I wash my hands, I will find my spot, unpack my supplies, and follow my teacher's instructions to get my day started.



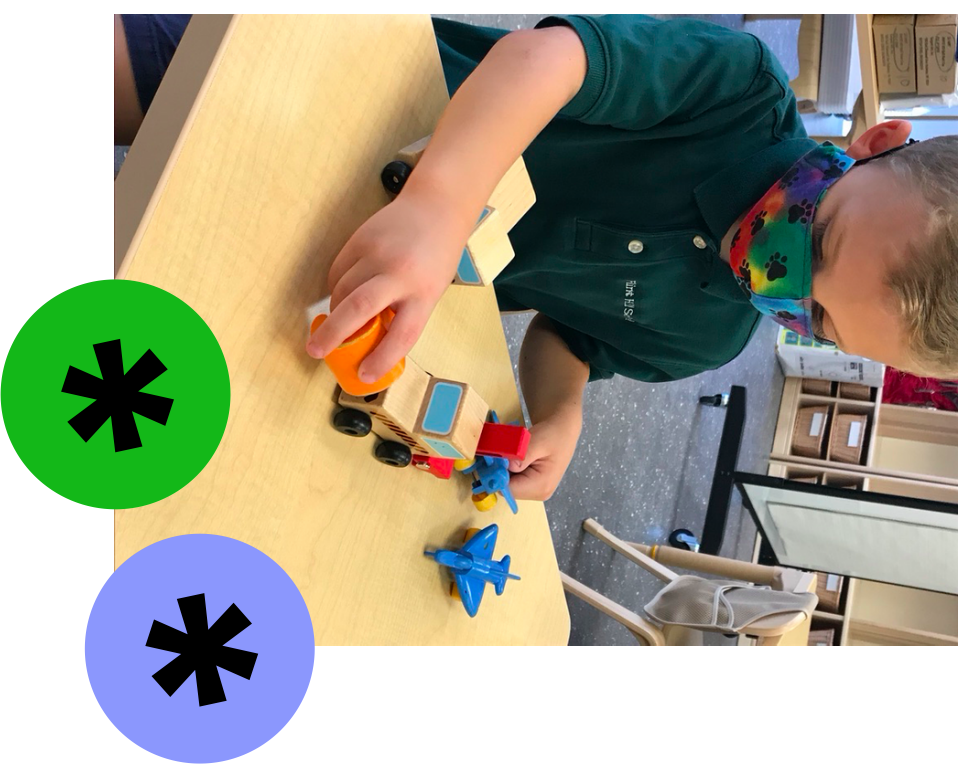
My teachers will wear masks. The masks cover their mouths and noses, but we can still see their eyes!



All students, including me, will be wearing masks to keep everyone at school healthy and safe.

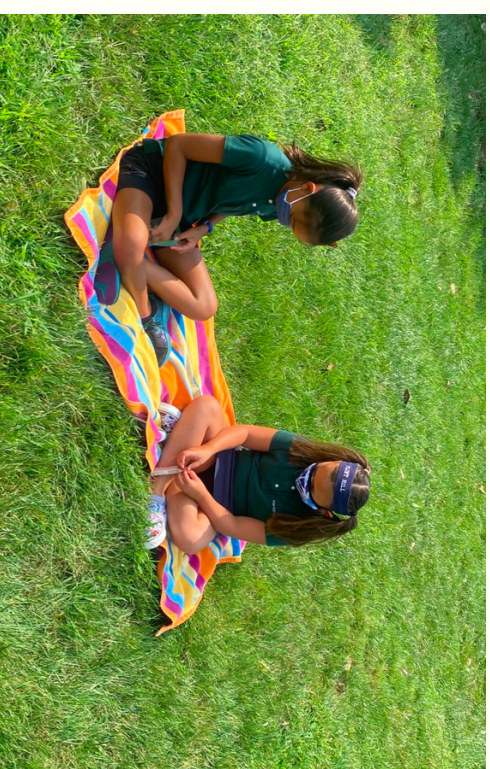


We will stay in our own classroom during the day instead of visiting other spaces in our school. This helps keep germs from spreading.

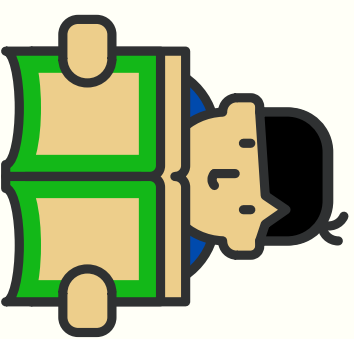
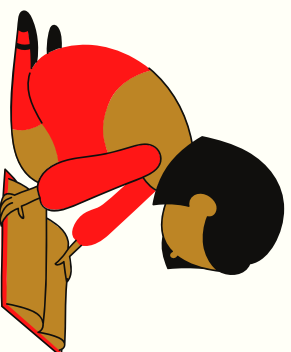


**We will get to spend time

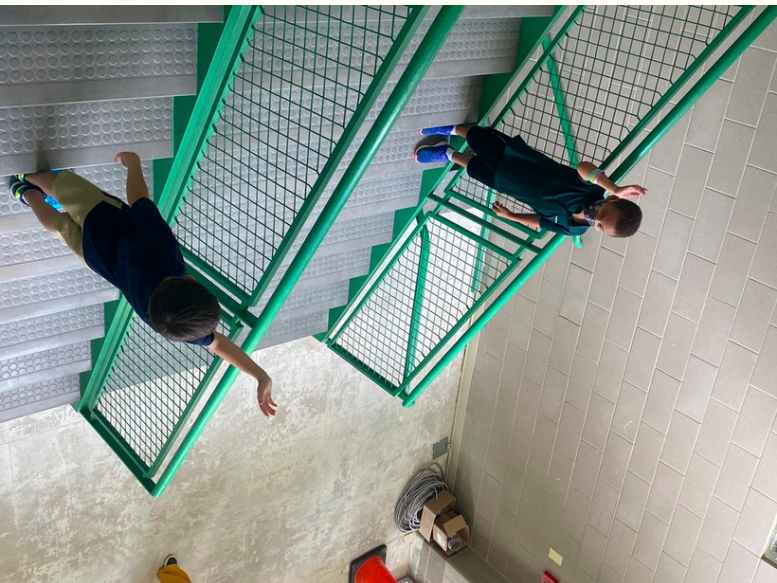
We will stay in our cohorts (COHORT is the word we use to describe the people in our class) during the day. We will all work together to make sure we don't get too close to friends who are not in my class.

see them around campus!**



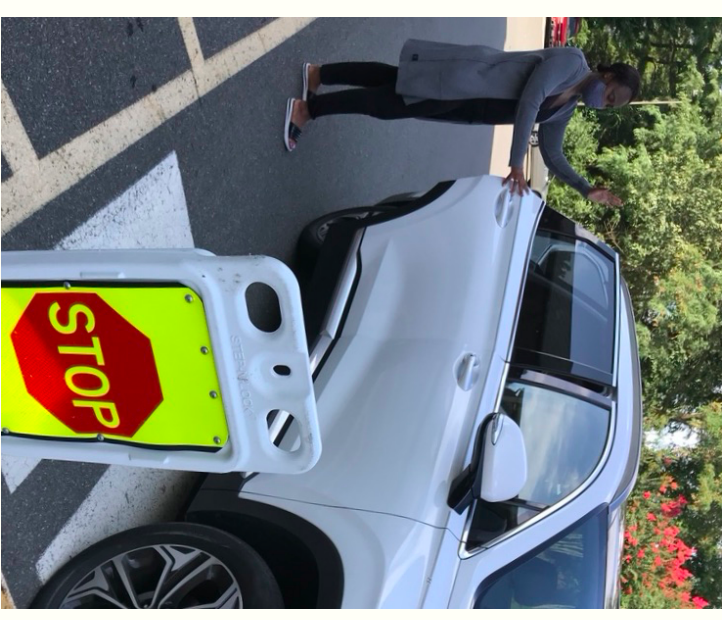


**When it's time to go home,

name called for carpool**

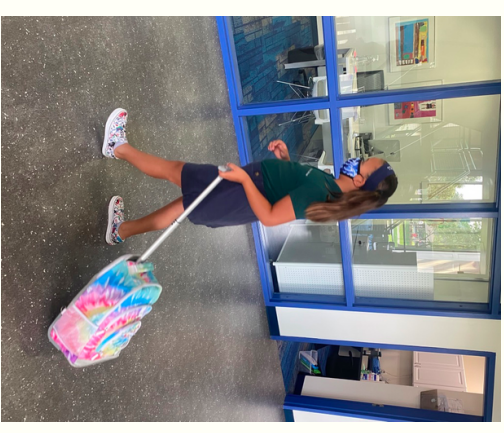
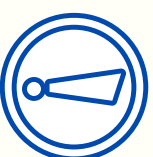




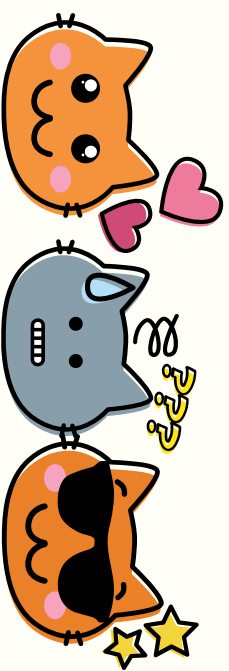
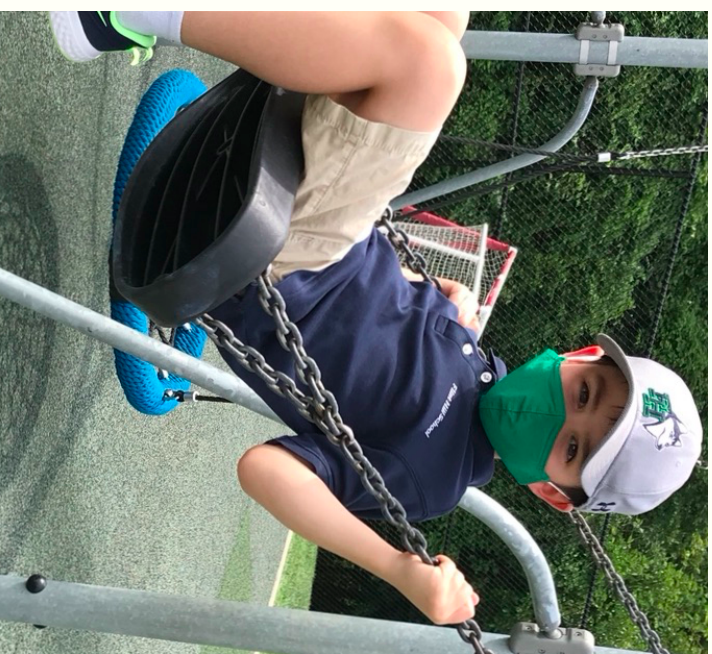
In carpool, one of the teachers will open the door to the car so I can get in.
