
Everyone will be wearing masks to keep our community healthy and safe. I will wait for someone to open my car door to let me out and I will go to the gym to have

We will get to spend time outside for break and for recess. Sometimes we might even get to eat lunch outside! We will still get to visit the playgrounds.



We might miss our friends and teachers in different classrooms. We can still wave at them and give them air hugs when we see them around campus!










When it's time to go home, I will gather my belongings and wait quietly in my classroom until I hear my name called for carpool

I notice that my day has some new routines.










New ways of doing things can bring up lots of different feelings. I can talk to my family, trusted adults, and friends about my feelings, the new routines, and any questions I have!
